

How to Propose a GVR Class or Club Workshop Currently Not Offered

Got an idea for a new class?

We welcome all club members to volunteer to teach new classes for the club. The club provides classes to GVR for any GVR member to attend. We also encourage members to lead workshops for club members. There are many topics that are missing from our Club course offerings. Many were taught before the pandemic. Now, we need members to revive those classes – or bring new ideas to the club.

Propose a GVR Class: If the proposed class is deemed to be a class that the club has resources to offer and is interested in providing to the GVR members, the information will go to the Club Registrar and dates, times, descriptions, and fees will be generated. New GV classes can only be added during the regular cycle of class submissions to GVR so that they appear in the printed catalog.

Propose a Club Workshop: If the proposed workshop is deemed to be an event that the club has resources to offer and is interested in providing to the club members, the information will go to the Club Registrar and dates and times will be added to the Club calendar on the club website at gvr lapidary club.org and material fees will be generated.

To propose a GVR Class or Club Workshop please provide the following information:

- Describe your class idea including location, desired day(s) and time, number of hours, number of students, number of classes per year.
- Provide an outline and photos or samples of class project or technique.
- List equipment and student materials needed. Provide supplier and cost if club needs to purchase these items.
- List safety items necessary to provide a safe class – closed-toe shoes, safety glasses, respiratory mask, etc.

Please submit your proposal to the chairperson of the Education Committee for both GVR Classes and Club Workshops.
